

Post-op care instructions following dental treatments under general anestheia

	One of our team members will contact you either in person or by phone at the end of the treatment.		
	Wait i	Wait in your car until the medical team contact you and guide you to the recovery	
	room where your child awaits. (Waiting time of about 30 to 60 min)		
	Diet		
	0	Start with a soft diet and return slowly to a regular one depending on your child's mood.	
	Extraction		
	0	Local anesthesia: Do not let your child bite his numbed lip.	
	0	Do not drink with a straw for 24h	
	0	Do not spit for 24h	
	0	Soft diet for 24h	
	0	Gently brush around the extraction site	
	0	Resorbable sutures: They will melt naturally within 2 weeks.	
	Root canal		
	0	Watch for abcess during toothbrushing	
	Analgesic		
	0	Your child was given Advil at your arrival to the general anesthesia clinic. If needed, you can give Tylenol in 6 to 8h.	
\checkmark	Dental Hygiene		
	0	It is normal to see some gum bleeding for few days.	
	0	Keep brushing and flossing to promote healing.	
\square	Our dental team will contact you in 2 to 3 days to take news on your child's recovery		
	and to schedule a follow-up appointment with your child's treating dentist.
